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A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 2, 8 and 9 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-131, 19-135, 19-146, 19-160 and 20-14, in order to appropriate \$6,270,448 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2017, and for other purposes.
