A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate \$76,615,687 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, to provide funding for the operation of all the branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions, and capital improvement projects, and other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. <u>Title</u>. The title of this act is as follows: To 2 appropriate the sum of \$76,615,687 from the General Fund of the 3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending 4 September 30, 2016, for the purpose of funding the operations of 5 all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of 6 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and 7 contributions, capital improvement projects. Of the total amount 8 of funds appropriated herein, \$1,000,000 shall be deemed to come 9 from funds available under the amended Compact from the education 10 sector, and \$1,056,546 shall be deemed to come from funds 11 available under the Supplemental Education Grant. The sum 12 appropriated herein shall be apportioned as follows:

13 Section 2. Operating expenses of the Executive Branch. The 14 sum of \$19,968,336, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is 15 hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States 16 of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, for 17 the purpose of funding the operations of the Executive Branch of

Section 12. Allotment and management of funds and lapse 13 dates.

14 (1) General provisions.

(a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in accordance
with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
Management Act of 1979.

(b) The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sums appropriated.

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1 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia; 2 (b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall be 3 the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia; 4 (c) Section 4 — the allottee of these funds shall be 5 the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Federated States of 6 Micronesia: (d) Section 5 – the allottee of these funds shall be 7 8 the Public Auditor of the Federated States of Micronesia; 9 (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these 10 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of 11 Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following subsections 12 of sections 8 through 9 of this act: 13 (i) Section 8, subsection (12)(a) through (d) -14 the allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the 15 respective State Supreme Court; 16 (ii) Section 8(12)(e) - the allottee shall be the 17 President of the College of Micronesia - FSM; (iii) Section 9(1)(a) through (c) - the allottee 18 19 of these funds shall be the President of the College of 20 Micronesia-FSM; and 21 (3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to 22 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of 23 September 30, 2016; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds appropriated 24 under section 9 of this act shall not lapse. 25
